

## MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

OF

## ALL PAKISTAN SOLVENT EXTRACTORS' ASSOCIATION

(1) NAME

The name of the Association shall be "ALL PAKISTAN SOLVENT EXTRACTORS' ASSOCIATION" hereinafter called the Association

## (2) REGISTERED OFFICE

The Registered office of the Association shall be situated in the Province of Punjab. The Branch/Circle offices may be set up at such place or places as the Association may determine from time to time.

## (3) AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The aim of the Association, which is non-political, is to unite the members in their common approach and for this purpose the objects of the Association are:
a) To encourage unity, mutual understanding and high ethical standard amongst its members.
b) To endeavor to improve the working conditions and facilities effective input for achievement of objects for which the Association has been established.
c) To take such steps as the Association considers desirable towards the promotion of the interest of trade, industry and services in Pakistan or outside Pakistan, specially related to concerned sector.
d) To place before Government and other public and official bodies the views of Members on matters affecting the interests of trade, industry and services in specified field of activities.
e) To attempt to adopt unified approach in matters of policy on all matters affecting the interest of trade, industry and services in Pakistan.
f) To acquire immovable properties by purchase, lease, firrewexchange or otherwise and to demolish, erect, alter, and/or maintain the same for the begiento the Association.
g) To manage the movable and immovable pr

h) To seek representations on various bodies dealing with issues of common interests.
i) To do such other things as are necessary in the general interest of its members including the holding or participation in exhibitions within or outside the Country.
j) To urge, support or oppose legislative or other measures and procure change of law or practice affecting the interest of commerce, industry and services or adversely affecting the common interests of business community.
k) To secure adequate representation of the Association on Government, public or statutory bodies and on trade and business/industrial delegations.

1) To accept any bequest, gift, donation or subscription towards or to accumulate and provide a fund or endowment or waqf and to invest the same and apply the income arising there from or to resort to the capital thereof for any object of the Association.
m) To resolve controversies and re-conciliate differences of opinion among members of the Association.
n) To promote education, awareness amongst the Members by holding Seminars, conducting educational sessions, inviting experts to deliver lectures and workshops.
o) To seek affiliation with the Federation of Pakistan Chamber of Commerce and Industry.
p) To accept deposits of money or goods for any object of the Association as may be deemed fit.
q) To subscribe, become and continue to remain member of Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce and Industry, and to procure from and communicate to any organization of Trade and Industry in Pakistan or abroad such information as may be conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Association.
r) To subscribe to any local or other charity and to grant any donations for any public purposes and to provide provident or superannuation fund or funds for the employees of the Association or otherwise to assist any such employees, their widows and children.
s) To communicate with Federal and Provincial Governments, Chambers of Commerce and Industry or other commercial and public bodies and do concert and promote measures for the protection of the aforesaid intere
t) To file, prosecute, defend or contest, join on aic in filitg proseeuting and defending any such actions, suits, applications, appeade, or defending any such actions, suits, applications, appeas, or therproceediitgs

Association may think proper or which may be conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Association.
u) To pay all costs, charges and expenses, preliminary and incidental to the promotion, formation, establishment or registration of the Association and the conduct of the affairs thereof.
v) To collect, circulate and disseminate statistics and other information relating to Commerce, Industry, Trade or services.
w) To enter into any arrangement with any Government Federal or Provincial or Authority, Municipal, local or otherwise that may seem conducive to the objects of the Association or any of them and to obtain from any such Government or Authority rights, concessions, privileges which the Association may think fit to obtain and to carry out any such arrangement, rights, privileges and concessions.
x) To sign, seal, execute and deliver all instruments, deeds, documents and writing whatsoever that may be found to be necessary or expedient in realization of the objects of the Association or conduct or its affairs.
y) To frame from time to time, such rules and laws as the Association may deem fit or proper for all or any of the objects, and to comply with all the requirements of the Trade Organizations Act 2013.
z) And generally to do all acts, deeds, and things which may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects stated herein above.
aa) To protect and promote the trade and to secure cooperation among members in general and those dealing in these lines in particular.
bb) To establish just and equitable principles in trade and commerce.
cc) To form a code or codes or practices to simplify and facilitate transaction of business.
dd) To undertake special inquiries and action for securing redressal of legitimate grievances of the members of the Association.
es) To establish and maintain information bureau, to prints and publish journals, periodicals newspapers, books, pamphlets, directories ocosind to establish and maintain library and reading rooms for the promotion of the objects of the ASSOciation.
ff) To arrange and convene conferences, lecture shows neethgs oil the subject affecting the interest of the members of the Association


gg ) To affiliate with any national or international trade organizations having objects altogether or in part similar to those of this Association for the purpose of securing the aims and objects of this association.
hh) To aid in subscribing money to any charitable or benevolent purposes or for the promotion generally of any matters of charity or other useful objects with a view to establish harmony and business relationship amongst various mercantile communities in general and Pakistani community in particular.
ii) To take such steps by personal or written appeals public meetings or otherwise as may from time to time be deemed expedient for the purpose of procuring contributions to the funds of the Association in the shape of donations, annual subscription or otherwise.
jj) To provide for help and encourage study and training in technical and commercial matters by granting scholarships, awarding prize-stipends or giving other monetary aids to institutions through such other ways and means as may be determined from time to time.
$\mathrm{kk})$ To run sections or departments including those relating to exports, imports, statistics, publicity and publications as may be determined from time to time.
11) To arrange international exhibitions in Pakistan or abroad and/or to participate in international exhibitions or forum in accordance with the aims and objectives of the Association.
mm ) To canvass, publicize, propagate and take all steps in the interest of the Association and for protection of the interests of the members and to consider, recommend and support all actions directed towards improvement in the conditions of the trade.
$\mathrm{nn})$ To enter into any arrangements with Government and public authorities, municipal, port, Railways, local or otherwise which may faster and consolidate the objectives of the Association or any of them whether individually or collectively for advancement of the interests of the trade.
oo) To lend, advance or borrow or raise monies or secure the payment of such monies in such manner as the Association may think fit and in particular manner by creation and issue of debenture or debenture stocks, perpetual or otherwise, charged upon all or any of the properties of the Association, present or future and to purchase redeem or pay such security or securities.

AND it is hereby declared that the objects set forth in any sub clauses of this clause shall not, except, where the context expressly so requires befin my wimited or restricted by reference to or inference from terms of any other subflaused ar by the name of the: Association.
(4) The income and property of the Association whosoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association as set forth in this Memorandum. No portion, thereof, shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly by way of dividend or bonus or by way of profit to the persons who at any time are or had been members of the Association or to any of them or to any persons claiming through them. Provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of remunerating to the officers or employees of the Association or to any member thereof or other person in return for any professional services actually rendered to the Association, or the payment of interest on money borrowed or rent for premises demised to the Association.
(5) The liability of the members is limited.
(6) Every member undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Association in the event of the same being wound up during the time that he is a member or within one year afterwards for payment of the debits and liabilities of the Association contracted before the time at which he cease to be a member and of the costs, charges and expenses or winding up the same and for adjustment of the rights, of contributories amongst themselves such amount as may be required, but not exceeding Rupees equivalent to the amount of Annual subscription of his category of membership.
(7) If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Association there remains after satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to, or divided among the members of the Association but shall be given or transferred to some institution having objects similar to the objects of the Association and approved under the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 to be determined by the Association at or before the time of the dissolution and in default thereof by such judge of the highest law court in the Province of the Punjab as may have or acquired jurisdiction in the matter.
(8) No addition, alteration and amendment shall be made in the Memorandum of Association or in the regulations contained in the Articles of Association for the time being in force unless the same shall have been previously submitted to and approved by the Government.
(9) The territories to which the objects of the Arsociation shedl extend are the whole of Pakistan.
